Proposal to Allow Graduate Teaching Assistants to teach the Graduate Reading Language Courses in Modern Languages and Linguistics-

It was noted that while these courses are designated at the 5000 level, they are really 2000 level courses.

Approved motion reads:

It was **moved** by Mr. Stakenas and **seconded** by Ms. Hunt to accept the proposal which reads:

**Graduate teaching assistants in Modern Languages will be allowed to teach the Graduate Reading Knowledge courses (GER 5060, SPN 5060, FRE 5060, ITA 5060, and RSN 5060) based on the following:**

- 1. The course, will emphasizing reading skills, is fundamentally the equivalent of the basic language courses which are taught routinely by teaching assistants.**
- 2. The graduate student teaching the course would continue to receive supervision by a full-time faculty member and would be required to register for the appropriate 5940 (Teaching Practicum) course.**
- 3. The course is routinely taught by graduate teaching assistants at other major universities.**
